1. ORIENTATION (3 HOURS)

Introductory meeting with your flight instructor will include U.S. citizenship verification, IACRA, FAA medical, and online study course setup, as well as general paperwork and program overview.



2. CORE GROUND TRAINING (20 HOURS)

2 Hours | Aircraft preflight to include a thorough walk around, flight control & aircraft overview, paperwork verification & fueling process

18 Hours | Six 3-hour blocks covering key areas:

- Principles & aerodynamics of flight & aircraft systems
- Aeronautical decision making - Risk management & medical factors
- Airport and emergency procedures
- Atmosphere, weather & environmental factors
- Airspace, sectional chart and plotter use
- Planning, navigation and aircraft performance



3. SOLO & CHECKRIDE PREPARATION (2 HOURS)

- **1 Hour** | Pre-solo written exam review
- **1 Hour** | Checkride preparation and scheduling
